Transformer & Equipment Building

Jordan VanTiem – Motor City Electric, Project Manager for the Transformer & Equipment Building project.

Gary Raska – Cargil Salt, Project Manager. We are replacing the existing power that feeds the entire facility with the new substation. Currently the feed is on the residential electrical grid, 4,800 volts along with the houses in the area. We are taking it off of that grid and we are building our own substation. DTE is bringing in a 40,000-volt industrial feed to the site that we are taking under ground and feeding a brand new station. We take the 40,000 volts and drop it down to 4,800 volts and then distribute it throughout the plant.

On the drawing you see two buildings on the drawing. The one to the south end is the substation, which converts the 40,000 volts from DTE to the 4800 volts for our usage. Then it goes to a switch gear room where we distribute throughout the plant.

Discussion continued about the power distribution within the plant along with the power they need to run everything in the plant. Gary and Jordan explained the drawings and the placement of the sub-station addition.
